Director's Report (Tim Sellars):

- No active planning currently, but still busy.
- NND planning region: GTOR Recommended to the Parties October 17.
- Dawson region: Hoping for end of March 2024 response from Parties.
- Southern Yukon: Recent meeting with How We Walk myth-busting Ch. 11 planning.
- Communications: News posted onto website + FB, Career Fair at CAFN
- Staffing: full capacity. Julia to go on maternity leave soon.
- List of previous Council Members is now posted on the website.

Chair's Report (Neil Salvin)

 Policy and Procedures overhaul: Council, Finance and HR complete, still working on Finance Policy and Record Management Policy.



Discussed implications of Council vacancy.

4. Traditional Knowledge Circle

Land Relationship Planner update (Micheal Jim)

- Circle needs 7 linguistic reps: 2 vacancies.
- Working on Proceedings from Gathering and February Elders Gathering.
- Copper Joe update: Lots of work with the LPR Model in neighbouring regions.

Action: Staff to post Gathering report to the Council's Shared Drive.

Action: Proceedings for the Gathering to be approved by Council and Circle before release.

• Northwest Boreal Partnership (Sam, Micheal, Kirsten, Copper Joe)

6. Dawson Planning Region

DRPC Update (Kirsten Reid)

- No active planning, Commission is not currently meeting.
- 1 Commission member's term ends in January reappointment process underway.
- Commission released update in November as a response to queries from the public.
- Working with YESAB on conformity check process for Dawson and other regions.

DRPC Preliminary Work Plan and Budget 2024-25 (Kirsten Reid)

- Preliminary work plan due in December; final work plan due in February.
 - o Focus for 2024-25 will be Final Recommended Plan.
 - o Budget includes 2nd Dawson-based planner.
 - o YG has approved carry over of \$107K to next fiscal.

- 2024-25 Budget

- o 10-year funding has not increased: may need to renegotiate with Dawson.
- o TK Circle -should be part of core budget: critical for implementing Ch. 11.

Action: 2024-25 Workplan corrections page 7, #3, \$72K instead of \$71K.

Action: Correct Council Member appointment terms.

Motion 2023-12-04: To approve the DRPC Preliminary Work Plan and Budget 2024-25. Moved by Neil Salvin; Seconded by Al Foster; *Motion Passed*

Financial Statements to October 31:

- Expenditures are within 2% of budget. Have spent \$460K of budgeted \$469K.

Motion 2023-12-05: To appoint Crowe Mackay as YLUPC auditor for 2023-24 fiscal year. Moved by Neil Salvin; Seconded by Al Foster; *Motion Passed*

Motion 2023-12-06: To implement Cost of Living Allowance adjustment of 6.8% based upon Yukon Bureau of Statistics April 1, 2022 for Whitehorse, effective April 1, 2024. Moved by Al Foster; Seconded by Neil Salvin; *Motion Passed*

8. Na-Cho Nyak Dun Planning Region

• YLUPC received a thank you from the Premier for submitting the Recommended General Terms of Reference. The response received was as expected.

9. Commission Orientation Manual

Contents Discussion

- Good template could be used for all commissions, not just NND.
- Useful not only for regional planning, but relationship building as well.
- Importance of TK was discussed: precedent-setting for other jurisdictions.

10. YG Updates

Bilateral Nature Agreement (Sarah Chan, YG Environment)

Presentation outlined the Canada-Yukon Nature Agreement:

- Protection of 25% of Canada's land and water by 2025
- Contribute towards Canada's 30x30 goal (not a YG commitment)
- Monitoring and protection of species at risk
- January workshop being planned
- Ecological Cumulative Effects Framework project is just starting now.



EMR Updates: Amber Church, YG EMR

- Dawson: TH/YG working to get consensus on modifications by March 2024.
- NND Region: Working on GTOR and MOU targeting end of fiscal 2023-24.
- Southern Lakes: Working on a collaboration agreement. YG is open to process outside Ch. 11, as long as it fulfills Ch. 11 obligations.
- Kluane Region: TWG and SLC have been created to start work on MOU and TOR.
- North Yukon: Quiet right now. VG is capacity poor.
- Peel Watershed: Making progress on plan implementation.
- YG regularly reaches out to nations not currently engaged in land use planning processes. "When they're ready to talk we're ready".

11. North Yukon Plan Review

- Staff produced a discussion paper on a North Yukon Plan Review with assessment of whether review is needed and options.
- NY Annex area is outstanding
- Council: Ideally a full plan review with a smaller Commission or original members.
- Staff will continue their work on this project and will seek an opportunity to discuss the options with the Parties, when ready.

12. Correspondence and Media

 Council discussed recent media articles outlining court cases relating to land use planning and Indigenous rights.
