#### 3.0 Public Lands Act

Mike Draper provided an update on the Public Lands Act.

- **Working groups** with First Nation membership, to do a deeper dive on 6 issues:
  - Backcountry land use (in progress)
  - Compliance (in progress)
  - Land Use Planning (summer/fall)
  - Decision Making
  - Roads



- Land Tenure
- A discussion paper on all six issues will be ready by the new year.
- Stakeholder working groups have been set up too.
- New timeline: The Lands Act by 2026-27.
- Comments on YLUPC's letter:
  - YG is building planning elements into the legislation,
  - o taking into account interim measures as well as plan implementation.

## • Resource road regulations:

- o Will address socioeconomic impacts.
- o May need to be amended if successor legislation goes through.
- o only regulations of their kind in Canada
- All stages of road development are included, from the construction phase to remediation.
- o Commissions could ask that certain roads fall under the regulations.
- o Access permits can be issued for portions of roads, for various purposes.
- Mike will provide the Council with an update in two months.

## **4.0 Meeting Debriefings**

  - o Representatives attended from AK, YT, NWT, BC.
  - Good discussions around cross border linkages.
- Land & Water Relationship Planning

  - o Surprised many didn't know about YLUPC and regional land use planning.
- Dawson Regional Planning Commission
  - Methods Report has been finalized and posted to the website.
  - TH and YG will have a combined response to the Dawson Recommended plan
  - o Commission feedback to Council re: strategic planning.
  - o Tim and Neil met with Tim G to discuss Peel Terms & Conditions
- YESAA CE Forum Summary Report (written summary provided)
  - Recognition of work done by DRPC and Sam cumulative effects frameworks for Yukon.
  - Section 110 and 112 discussions
  - o Increasing recognition of socioeconomic and sociocultural impacts.

- Dawson TH and YG continuing review of Recommended Plan.
- Dawson Senior Planner, Nicole Percival has left her position. We are hiring a replacement. The hiring committee includes YG, TH and Commission Chair. Budget is for 2 positions.
- NND Region ToR is being developed and a technical working group struck.
- Carcross/Teslin working group is underway.
- YLUPC Strategic Planning session: May 23 and 24.
- New website has been launched.
- Neil and Tim gave a presentation at the RRC Annual General Workshop.
- Annual report is underway.
- Received 1<sup>st</sup> payment from Yukon for this fiscal year.
- Annual audit is underway.
- IPTK appointments are in place. Joe and Tim are working to setup an IPTK meeting.

Action: YLUPC staff to invite previous IPTK members to upcoming IPTK meeting. Action: Staff to email Council the NND region draft ToR with updates.

### **6.0 Lois Craig's Departure/Appreciation**

Council members and guests thanked Lois for her many years of dedication to YLUPC and wished her well moving forward.

#### 7.0 10-Year Funding Projections

Council discussed the Regional Planning Funding Adequacy.

- Potential value of communicating the memo beyond Council.
- Revisions were made to the options presented.
- There are many possibilities as to how planning could unfold and that planning outside of Chapter 11 is not included here.

#### Discussion

- Regional planning hubs concept: e.g. shared offices/resources in Dawson.
- Indigenous Stewardship Framework phase of planning needs to be prioritized.
- How We Walk process millions of dollars to prepare them to engage. First Nations shouldn't have to look for funding for preplanning work.
- Need an agreement between YG and FNs that triggers Chapter 11 funding to flow.
- Anticipating a set of questions from the Parties as part of the funding review.



Action: Staff to present the Funding Adequacy memo to the Parties, emphasizing the importance of pre-planning work/funding, for review and then circulate to Council.
