- Dawson is near the end of their public engagement period, ending Nov 1, 2021, the remaining six weeks will be the busiest.
- Sept 28 and 29,2021 CE workshop (Whitehorse)

- Oct 12 13, 2021 Dawson Public Engagement
- Oct 19,2021 Public Engagement in Whitehorse tentative
- Oct 25 29,2021 the last few engagement meetings

### Key Highlights of Interim Report

- Release of Draft Plan June 15, 2021, Draft Plan Plain language summary, Highlights Document, Communication Plan, two
  new releases, two mailers to Yukon residents, survey for Draft Plan feedback illustration map of Cumulative effects, all
  complete.
- All Dawson meetings and engagements are on the website to ensure an open/transparent process.
- July 30, 2021 Final Audited Financial Statements complete.

## Budget highlights by Senior Land Use Planner

- Over spent 2.5 % as of August expenses, the overage is from all the good engagement work that has been done.
- Meeting facilitation has not been required as much, however, printing of the Draft Plan has been costly.
- Increase Planning Services, A certified evaluator will be utilized, DRPC is seeking financial support from the Council for the evaluator.
- Council to contribute \$10,000 to assist the DRPC with the evaluator.
- Decreased Recommended Plan Production to compensate for other increased expenses.
- The Senior Land Use Planner indicated Dawson will not go over budget.
- Any feedback received after Nov 1, 2021 may not make it into the assessment process.
- Council recommended the Commission may need a couple technical advisors, no dollars have been allocated to this
  possible additional expense.

- Council has supplied funds in the past for expenses a commission as needed.
- A risk to the commission is that they don't get timely feedback from the Parties. This has been communicated by the Commission on many levels.
- If a letter is sent to YG about requesting feedback for the Dawson Plan in a timely manner, a similar discussion with Tr'ondëk Hwëch'in may be needed..
